ACADEMIC PREPARATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Academic Preparation

All applications are reviewed individually by the admissions committee. It is important to note that some differences in preparation and academic background may be considered. The applicants who are best suited for Rensselaer will have completed four years of English, four years of mathematics through pre-calculus, three years of science, and three years of social studies and/or history. Additionally, the admissions committee pays particular attention to candidates who demonstrate qualities and talents that will contribute to the richness of the Rensselaer community.

Standardized Test Requirements

All standardized tests must be taken by December 31.

- SAT (critical reading, math, and writing) or ACT (which must include the optional writing component)
- SAT Subject Tests in a math and a science for accelerated program applicants only (or ACT, which must include the optional writing component, in lieu of SAT and SAT Subject Tests)
- TOEFL for international applicants (minimum 230 CBT/88 iBT/570 PBT)

Note: Please include Rensselaer's institutional code of 2757 for the SAT and TOEFL exams, and include the college code of 2866 for the ACT. This will ensure that your scores arrive at Rensselaer's Admissions Office.

Required Essay Questions

Choose from the degree-specific guidelines below and include your completed essay with the application form. The essay should be no more than 1–2 pages.

- **Accelerated Programs (Law and Physician-Scientist):** State your reasons for aspiring to a career in law or medicine.
- **Architecture:** State your reasons for choosing architecture as your profession.
- **Electronic Arts:** Discuss your interests in the field of electronic arts and state how this is reflected in your portfolio.
- **All Other Programs:** Choose one topic listed below or submit a personal essay of your choice
 - 1) Describe a significant experience or achievement that has special meaning to you.
 - 2) Indicate a person who has had a significant influence on you and describe that influence.
 - 3) "They'll say I impacted the 21st century by my work in..."
